**III) CELEBRATIONS/OBSERVATIONS/EVENTS:****A) HEALTHY LIFESTYLE MANAGEMENT THROUGH NATUROPATHY AND YOGA:**

On Wednesday, the 20<sup>th</sup> of April, 2022, a very useful and an interesting session was organised at BVBV-NIRD & PR Campus on **HEALTHY LIFESTYLE MANAGEMENT THROUGH NATUROPATHY AND YOGA** by the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India on the occasion of 'Azadika Amrit Mahotsav' in the name of 'Rogmukth Bharat Abhiyan' in association with National Institute of Naturopathy, Pune along with the Dept. of Naturopathy & Yoga, addlife, part of Basavatarakam Indo-American cancer Hospital & Research Institute.

The Sessions were taken by Dr C Sumathi for Classes-6 & 7 and Dr Uday Kumar for Classes-8-10 from 8.30 am to 9.30 am.

**The following points were stressed by the speakers:**

1. Eat food regularly and at the correct time.
2. The food that is eaten must look good, taste good, smell good, must be nutritious, and must be of one's own choice.
3. Eat more fruits daily for free bowel movements.
4. Do not drink water with food, drink either before or after.
5. Drink water intermittently to avoid gall stones, mouth ulcers, bladder cancers, etc.
6. Practice YOGA to balance mind and body.
7. MEDITATION helps in improving concentration and calming down the mind.
8. EXERCISE regularly for 45 minutes to 1 hour.
9. Read the book IKIGAI which tells about the Japanese secret to a long and happy life.
10. Eat well and Be Positive.

The lessons imparted during the workshop promoted physical, mental, social and mental well-being.

The Session concluded with the demonstration of the breathing exercises-Anulom-Vilom; KapalBhati and Bhramari Pranayama and the children promised to practise aforesaid habits.

#### B) LIPPAN ART WORKSHOP CONDUCTED FOR CLASS VIII B ON 21-4-2022:

Art is divine. Keeping in view the need to foster a positive culture and climate in the learning scenario, Lippan Art workshop was organized for class 8B students on 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2022.

Lippan artwork is the traditional artwork of the desert region of Rajasthan and Gujarat. 'Lippan' means to apply. Beautiful designs using camels, birds, trees, flowers, peacocks and other nature-inspired motifs are created on the wall of homes using mud, thread, and mirrors. Deities and symbols that bring prosperity and peace to homes are creatively designed in this art form. Mud and mirror work is mainly done by the women of the Rabari community. The women are so experienced in this art form that they usually don't draw or trace a pattern before beginning work. Rabari is the pastoral community of Kutch, living on the outskirts of its villages. They dwell in a few clusters of communal or family houses known as Bhungas which are designed and built to take care of their practical needs in the harsh climate of Kutch. This art form has no records available to trace its origin.

Mrs. Sowmya Panda, our primary teacher, and the day's resource person facilitated children with the demonstration cum technique of this art form. The program began with the lighting of the lamp by the principal Shri B.Ravi Kiran. In his address, he encouraged children to learn well and spread their knowledge. This workshop was conducted to inculcate respect for handicrafts and a sense of preservation of our great Indian ethnicity. Mrs. Sophiya Reshma and Mr. Narender both were present and guided children. Near about 33 students participated in this workshop

**C) ADMISSION PROCESS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR-2022-23:**

The admissions for LKG and UKG for the year 2022-23 were taken on 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> June respectively through a lottery method on the school premises. All the parents of the applicants were invited and in their presence, the entire process was held. The school principal Dr. B. Ravi Kiran, one of the senior faculty, Smt. D. Suhasini, and administrative staff organised the event.

Shri. Ravi Kiran, the Principal briefed the admission process to the parents and it was carried out according to the categories decided upon beforehand. Here is a brief description of the process:

Two hundred coins bearing the registration numbers were displayed on a table. A parent was invited to segregate the coins as per the categories mentioned and the coins were put in boxes. Then the coins corresponding to the number of admissions to be taken in that particular category were picked up by the kids at random. All the selected coins were dropped in a box labeled 'SELECTED'. This process was continued for all the categories.

The selected list was displayed on the notice board and messages were also sent personally.

The parents of the selected applicants and the students were welcomed in to the Bhavan's family. Dr. Kiran conveyed his gratitude and showered the students with blessings.

**D) Health Awareness camp and Awareness programme at BVB, Hyderabad Kendra:**

On the occasion of International Yoga Day, a Health Awareness Camp and Cancer Awareness programme were organized by Add Life Naturopathy and Yoga Department, Basava Tarakam Cancer Institute at BVB, Hyderabad Kendra on 18<sup>th</sup> June 2022 from 10.30 am to 12.30 pm. The topics of the programme were 'Cancer Awareness, its prevention and early detection' by Dr.Kalpna Raghunath, Associate Director, Academics, Add Life and screening programme and 'Management of day to day ailments through Naturopathy and Yoga Holistic Approach' by Dr.C.Sumati, HOD, Naturopathy and Yoga, Add Life.

A hearty welcome was extended to Sri S.Gopalakrishnan, Vice-Chairman, Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan's Hyderabad Kendra, Smt.C.Rama Devi, Academic Director, the day's guests, Principals and teachers of the four Bhavan's schools at Hyderabad to the event and it was symbolized by lighting the lamp and prayer.

Kalpana madam also included cancer screening, methods of treatment, dispelled the fear of cancer, and busted myths about cancer treatment. Madam specified warning signs of cancer, lifestyle, and protective factors to prevent cancer. Madam's speech conveyed 'promotion of Health and prevention of Disease'.

Dr.Sumati spoke on Naturopathy – techniques to control diseases – with food, exercise and massage. Madam focused on thyroid problems -causes and preventive measures. Madam emphasized the practice of yogasanas and the role of water in cleansing our bodies.

The guests of the day Dr.Kalpana Raghunath and Dr.C.Sumati were felicitated by Sri S. Gopalakrishnan, and Dr.r.A.Rani Principal of BVB Atmakuri Rama Rao school proposed a Vote of Thanks.

The workshop reaffirmed that health is indeed the greatest wealth. Through this workshop, the teachers got an opportunity to reflect and acknowledge the priceless role a person's health plays in their own life.

- The school PET Mr.V.Murali Krishna demonstrated five breathing exercises. They included:

  - b. Kumbhaka Pranayama
  - c. Simhasana Pranayama
  - d. Mrigi Mudra pranayama and

- The students took active participation and made it a wonderful show. All the asanas were performed in a calm and peaceful atmosphere in the midst of “Omkar” music.
- The show ended by taking a vow to incorporate these asanas into our daily life to cruise towards a healthy life.
